VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE MAYOR UPDATE

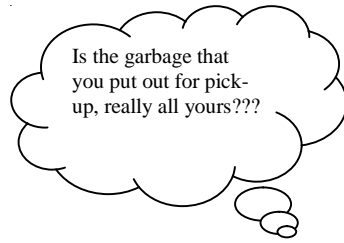
