VILLAGE OF SHELL LAKE MAYOR UPDATE

Thank you to the citizens that
have paid their 2008 taxes, also
to the citizens that have paid their
tax arrears. Just in the month of
September, operating expenses
amounted to \$26,394.32.
Payables were for matters such as:
police services; water and sewage
testing; wages; SaskEnergy and
Power; garbage pickup; phone;
postage; fuel; supplies.

Of the taxes collected up to the
end of September, \$50,453 was
submitted to Sask. Rivers School
Division for the school taxes.

Property owners who have tax
arrears will soon be faced with
tax enforcement. Tax arrears
weaken the effort to provide the
village with sustained growth
and viability.

The final date for the 2008 tax
payments is December 31st.
